Sub.: Guidelines for diversion of forest land for non-forest purposes under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 – Clarification.

## Sir,

Detailed guidelines for submission of proposals for diversion of forest land for non-forestry purposes under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 were finalised and circulated to all the State Government / Union Territories by the Ministry of Environment & Forests vide letter number 2-1/2003 dated 20.10.2003, Para 4.2(i) of the guidelines states that the non forest land which has been transferred and mutated in favour of State Forest Department for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation shall be notified as RF/PF under Indian Forest Act, 1927 prior to Stage – II clearance (formal approval). In this regard, it is clarified that the State / UT Government should notify such non-forest land under section-4 for reserved forest or under section-29 for protected forest, of Indian Forest Act, 1927 prior to Stage II, clearance. It issues with the approval of the competent authority.
