I am directed to refer your letter No.F.1(9)Forest/96 Pt. dated 04.09.2000 and this office letter of even number dated 3rd May, 1999 on the above mentioned subject and to say that collection of such forest produce should be as far as manually where local modes of transportation like bullock-carts, camel-carts, etc. is used and only in exceptional cases with the approval of concerned Divisional Forest Officers, tractors inputed with trolley may be used. It shall be ensured that no damage is done to the forest area.
