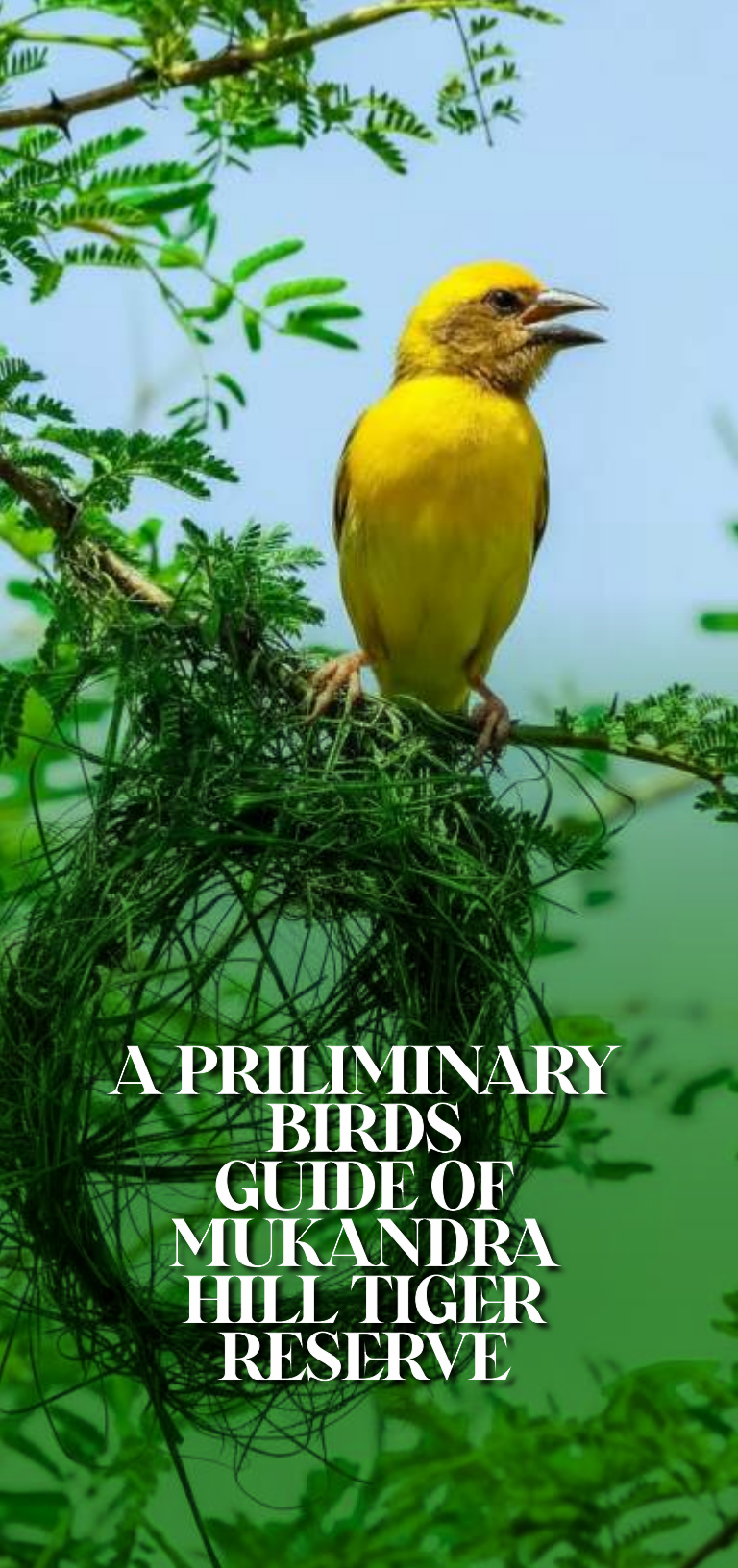

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CONTENT

MUKUNDARA HILLS TIGER RESERVE

The Mukandra Hills Tiger Reserve is located in the southeastern part of Rajasthan. It is the third tiger reserve in the state. The reserve spans across the districts of Kota, Bundi, Jhalawar, and Chittorgarh. In 1955, it was declared a protected area. Later, along with Jawahar Sagar Wildlife Sanctuary (1975) and the National Chambal Sanctuary (1983), forming a larger conservation area. The Mukandra Hills were officially declared as Rajasthan's third tiger reserve in 2013.

The reserve covers a total area of 1135.78 square kilometers, including a core zone of 690.71 square kilometers and a buffer zone of 445.07 square kilometers. The MHTR have a unique habitat, characterised by II type dry deciduous forest interspersed with grasslands, scrublands, wetlands and riverine habitat with rocky terrain. The different types of habitats support a rich floral diversity with Kala Dhok (*Anogeissus pendula*), Khair (*Senegalia catechu*), Ber (*Ziziphus* spp.) and faunal species like Tiger (*Panthera tigris*), Common Leopard (*Panthera Pardus*), Sloth Bear (*Melursus ursinus*) and Indian vulture (*Gyps indicus*), Crested Treeswift (*Hemiprocne cornata*), Greater White-fronted Goose (*Anser albifrons*) with Indian Rock Python (*Python molurus*), Mugger (*Crocodylus palustris*), Spectacled Cobra (*Naja naja*). This area holds Rajasthan's largest Indian Vulture (*Gyps indicus*) breeding colony in the gorge of the Chambal River.

You will find details and photographs of 217 bird species. many of which you are likely to encounter during your visit to the reserve.



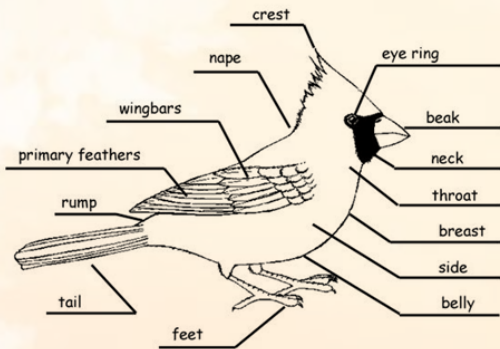
INTRODUCTION

How to identify birds

Learning to identify birds is a fun skill. When you see a bird, look for these things:

- **Size and Shape:** Is it small like a sparrow or big like a crow? Does it have a long neck or a round body? The overall shape is a big clue.
- **Colours:** Look at the colours of its feathers. Does it have a bright red patch, a white stripe on its wing, or a yellow belly?
- **Where You See It:** Where did you find the bird? Was it near a river, on a tree, or on the ground? Knowing where a bird lives can help you figure out what it is.
- **Activity:** Is the bird hopping on the ground, on a branch/wire, is foraging or singing or soaring high above in the sky? You notice numerous activities once you start observing birds.
- **Sounds:** Listen to its calls and songs. Every bird has a unique sound.

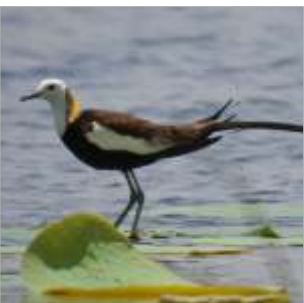
